Opening number:

You are not judged during opening number. HOWEVER, remember this is the judges 1st impression of you. Opening number will be nothing more than a parade of contestants. The theme this year is "Its Showtime". You will be provided with a Miss Nashville T-shirt which you will wear in the opening number. Examples of what to wear with it are: jeans, skirts, shorts, etc, you can also have accessories, examples would be, jewelry, handbags, and shoes of your choice. If you have any questions, please contact me. You will be called up one at a time on stage and will be introduced. Example: Contestant #1 is Tonya Collins. WE WILL PRACTICE AT REHEARSAL Friday April 24th, 2020 at

6:00pm at Nash Central Middle School. The rehearsal will be mandatory. We will run through the pageant start to finish.

Beauty:

****Each contestant must have an escort during the Beauty competition. This person can be your father, grandfather, brother, etc.**** Teen and Miss Division: Contestant will wear a long pageant/evening/prom gown and will be judged on poise, appearance, and personality. Please keep all hair and makeup age appropriate.

On Stage Question:

Both Teen and Miss Division will be asked one on stage question during the casual wear part of the pageant.

Casual Wear:

This is any cute outfit this is off the rack. You may embellish it with stones, bows, ribbons, etc. Show your personality and style.

Photogenic:

Each Contestant will need to attend a photo session. I will let you know the date, location and time. The photographer will schedule, and I will let you know. The fee will be 30 to 45 dollars and that will include, a 4X6, 8x10 and some prints, we will display your 8x10 in the front entrance on pageant night. If you cannot attend the session and the photographer cannot set another time for you, you will forfeit your photogenic entry and will not be in the newspaper. Please contact the director if you set up another time with the photographer or cannot make it happen. There will be one overall photogenic winner who will receive a plaque.

Sponsors:

Each contestant is encouraged to collect sponsorship money and the sponsors name will be listed in the program book with your picture.

Sponsors can give any amount they wish, and this can come from Parents, grandparents' businesses, etc. All money should be made payable to the Nashville Chamber of Commerce. Please send sponsorship form and sponsorship money in together along with your entry fee of 100 dollars into the director before the deadline. Any sponsor money collected afterwards must be turned in at the contestant meeting that will be held March 21st, time and location to be announced.

Ads:

Also, in addition to sponsor(s), you can sell adds. If any of your sponsors would like to buy an add please see the enclosed form for ads. These ads will appear in the program book. The prices and sizes are listed on the form, as well as contact information. All ad money must be turned in before the deadline or on the day of at the contestant meeting on March 21st time and location to be announced. We will have an overall winner for sponsor and ad money collected.

RULES:

- All judged decisions are final. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated and result in disqualification without a refund.
- You can pick up your pictures and scoresheets immediately following the pageant from the auditor at the judges table.
- No video camera will be allowed because we will have a professional videographer on site to take order for videos. If you take pictures at the pageant, please be respectful of others that are trying to watch the pageant. Please do not stand in front of the videographer.

-If there is not an adequate number of contestants for the pageant on that date, it may be rescheduled for a better day or may be canceled. This will depend on the response of the contestants. If cancelled all together, money will be refunded.

-Only one chaperone can be backstage with each contestant. Each contestant will receive a wrist band for your chaperone. This is always to be worn. If you wish to have a hair/makeup artist with you backstage in addition to your chaperone, they must pay to get in at the front door.

-When the pageant is over, please be considerate of the school custodian and exit the gym quickly so that he/she can clean and lock up as soon as possible. All winners, please remain on stage for a group photo to be used in the newspaper and our Facebook Page.

Expectations:

We would like for each queen to visit the Nashville Blooming Festival and the Nashville Blooming Festival Parade. Also represent your title at various other parades and events, such as anything that the Nashville Chamber may have, or other parades such as the Pumpkin Parade and you are also able to visit other pageants as well to represent your title as a visiting queen, The director will be in touch. The queens are expected to attend the pageant next year to crown the new winners. If you would like to keep a scrapbook of your appearances, etc we can display this at the next pageant. Also, for next year's pageant we would like to display a portrait of you, director will have more information.

Awards:

Winners for each division will receive a trophy, sash, crown and flowers.

Any contestant who collects \$1,000 or more in sponsorship and/or ad money will receive \$100.

The contestant who collects OVERALL the most money in sponsorship and/or ad money will receive an additional \$100.

There will be one Overall Photogenic Winner. She will receive a plaque.
Miss Nashville 2020 (17-20 years) will receive a \$500 scholarship.
